



THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBOURG

**BY-LAW NUMBER 037-2019**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 014-2017, A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF ONTARIO (AS REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION OF ONTARIO) AND THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBOURG FOR THE FEDERAL PUBLIC TRANSIT INFRASTRUCTURE FUND (PTIF) PHASE ONE (ONTARIO) TRANSFER PAYMENT AGREEMENT.**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides in part that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;


**AND WHEREAS** the Government of Canada established the Public Transit Infrastructure Fund (PTIF) to upgrade and improve public transit systems as a renewed commitment to infrastructure priorities across Canada and in a bilateral agreement and partnership with the Province of Ontario to identify projects, municipal and provincial, and be responsible for the transfer of PTIF funds to eligible municipalities pursuant to transfer payment agreements.


**AND WHEREAS** the Cobourg Municipal Council has expressed a desire to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Transportation of Ontario for a financial contribution to assist the upgrade and improvement of the Town of Cobourg Public Transit System.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to execute on behalf of the Corporation an Amending Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister responsible for the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario, regarding the Transfer Payment Agreement for the Public Transit Infrastructure Fund (PTIF).
2. **THAT** the Director of Public Works, Laurie Wills, be named the authorized representative of the Recipient for the Agreement.
3. **THAT** the expiration date of the Agreement is March 31, 2021.
4. **THAT** this By-law shall take effect upon the date of final passing.
